A BILL

To require the Secretary of the Interior to review the suitability for inclusion in the National Wilderness Preservation System of the Everglades expansion area.

- 3 SECTION 1. REVIEW OF EVERGLADES EXPANSION AREA
- 4 FOR POTENTIAL AS WILDERNESS.
- 5 (a) DEFINITION OF ADDITION.—In this section, the
- 6 term "addition" has the meaning given the term in section
- 7 101(c) of the Everglades National Park Protection and
- 8 Expansion Act of 1989 (16 U.S.C. 410r–5(c)).

1	(b) Review and Report.—Subject to subsection
2	(c), in accordance with section 3 of the Wilderness Act
3	(16 U.S.C. 1132), the Secretary of the Interior shall re-
4	view and report on the suitability for inclusion in the Na-
5	tional Wilderness Preservation System of any part of the
6	addition.
7	(c) Effective Date.—Subsection (b) shall take
8	effect—
9	(1) on the date of submission to Congress of
10	the proposed comprehensive plan to restore, pre-
11	serve, and protect the South Florida ecosystem re-
12	quired by section 528(b) of the Water Resources De-
13	velopment Act of 1996 (110 Stat. 3767); but
14	(2) only if the plan does not specify that con-
15	struction and water storage are required in the addi-
16	tion (as determined by the Secretary of the Inte-
