Mr. GRAHAM introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred

A BILL

For the relief of Rocco A. Trecosta of Fort Lauderdale,
Florida.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. COMPENSATION OF BACK PAY.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of the Treasury
5 shall pay, out of any money in the Treasury not otherwise
6 appropriated, to Mr. Rocco A. Trecosta of Fort Lauder-
7 dale, Florida, the sum of \$10,000 for compensation for
8 back pay not received as an employee of the Department
9 of Defense Overseas Dependent Schools for service per-
10 formed during the period beginning April 14, 1966,
11 through June 30, 1975.

1 (b) NO INFERENCE OF LIABILITY.—Nothing in this
2 section shall be construed as an inference of liability on
3 the part of the United States.

4 (c) FULL SATISFACTION OF CLAIMS.—The payment
5 authorized under subsection (a) shall be in full satisfaction
6 of all claims of Rocco A. Trecoستا against the United
7 States for back pay in connection with his service in the
8 Department of Defense Overseas Dependent Schools.

9 (d) LIMITATION ON AGENTS AND ATTORNEYS
10 FEES.—No more than 10 percent of the payment author-
11 ized by this Act may be paid to or received by any agent
12 or attorney for services rendered in connection with ob-
13 taining such payment, any contract to the contrary not-
14 withstanding. Any person who violates this subsection
15 shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be subject to
16 a fine in the amount provided in title 18, United States
17 Code.
