A BILL

To amend the Small Business Act to extend the authorization for the drug-free workplace program.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Drug-Free Workplace
5 Fair Demonstration Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. DRUG-FREE WORKPLACE PROGRAM EXTENSION.**

7 Section 27(g)(1) of the Small Business Act (15
8 U.S.C. 654(g)(1)) is amended by striking “\$10,000,000

- 1 for fiscal years 1999 and 2000” and inserting
- 2 “\$20,000,000 for fiscal years 1999 through 2002”.
