## A BILL

To amend the U.S. Holocaust Assets Commission Act of 1998 to extend the period by which the final report is due and to authorize additional funding.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “U.S. Holocaust Assets  
5 Commission Extension Act of 1999”.

6 **SEC. 2. AMENDMENTS TO THE U.S. HOLOCAUST ASSETS**  
7 **COMMISSION ACT OF 1998.**

8 (a) EXTENSION OF TIME FOR FINAL REPORT.—Sec-  
9 tion 3(d)(1) of the U.S. Holocaust Assets Commission Act

1 of 1998 (22 U.S.C. 1621 nt.) is amended by striking “De-  
2 cember 31, 1999” and inserting in lieu thereof “December  
3 31, 2000”.

4 (b) REAUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—Sec-  
5 tion 9 of the U.S. Holocaust Assets Commission Act of  
6 1998 (22 U.S.C. 1621 nt.) is amended—

7 (1) by striking “3,500,000” and inserting in  
8 lieu thereof “\$6,000,000”; and

9 (2) by striking “1999, and 2000,” and insert-  
10 ing in lieu thereof “1999, 2000, and 2001,”.
