**A BILL**

To extend the authorization of appropriations for activities at Long Island Sound.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. LONG ISLAND SOUND.**

4       Section 119(e) of the Federal Water Pollution Con-  
5       trol Act (33 U.S.C. 1269(e)) is amended—

1           (1) in paragraph (1), by striking “1991  
2           through 2001” and inserting “2000 through 2005”;  
3           and

4           (2) in paragraph (2), by striking “not to exceed  
5           \$3,000,000 for each of the fiscal years 1991 through  
6           2001” and inserting “not to exceed \$10,000,000 for  
7           each of fiscal years 2000 through 2005”.
