## A BILL

To require the Secretary of Education to correct poverty data to account for cost of living differences.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. POVERTY DATA.
- 4 Title XIV of the Elementary and Secondary Edu-
- 5 cation Act of 1965 (20 U.S.C. 8801 et seq.) is amended
- 6 by adding at the end the following:
- 7 "PART I—POVERTY DATA ADJUSTMENTS
- 8 "SEC. 14901. POVERTY DATA ADJUSTMENTS.
- 9 "Whenever the Secretary uses any data that relates
- 10 to the incidence of poverty and is produced or published

- 1 by or for the Secretary of Commerce for subnational,
- 2 State or substate areas, the Secretary shall adjust the
- 3 data to account for differences in the cost of living in the
- 4 areas.".
- 5 SEC. 2. SHORT TITLE.
- 6 This Act may be cited as the "Education Grant For-
- 7 mula Adjustment Act of 1999".
