- 3 SECTION 1. REMOVAL OF LIMIT ON AMOUNT OF MEDICAID
- 4 DISPROPORTIONATE SHARE HOSPITAL PAY-
- 5 MENT FOR HOSPITALS IN OHIO.
- 6 (a) In General.—Section 1923(g)(1) of the Social
- 7 Security Act (42 U.S.C. 1396r-4(g)(1)) is amended—

1	(1) in subparagraph (A), by striking "A" and
2	inserting "Except as provided in subparagraph (D),
3	a''; and
4	(2) by adding at the end the following new sub-
5	paragraph:
6	"(D) Exception.—The limitations in sub-
7	paragraphs (A) and (C) shall not apply to pay-
8	ments made to hospitals (other than institu-
9	tions for mental diseases or other mental health
10	facilities) located in Ohio.".
11	(b) Effective Date.—The amendments made by
12	subsection (a) shall apply to payments and payment ad-
13	justments made to hospitals on or after July 1 1999
