To amend the Fair Labor Standards Act of 1938 to increase the Federal minimum wage.

- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Fair Minimum Wage
- 5 Act of 1999".

#### 1 SEC. 2. MINIMUM WAGE INCREASE.

- 2 (a) Wage.—Paragraph (1) of section 6(a) of the Fair
- 3 Labor Standards Act of 1938 (29 U.S.C. 206(a)(1)) is
- 4 amended to read as follows:
- 5 "(1) except as otherwise provided in this sec-
- 6 tion, not less than—
- 7 "(A) \$5.65 an hour during the year begin-
- 8 ning on January 1, 2000; and
- 9 "(B) \$6.15 an hour beginning on January
- 10 1, 2001;".
- 11 (b) Effective Date.—The amendment made by
- 12 subsection (a) takes effect on January 1, 2000.
- 13 SEC. 3. APPLICABILITY OF MINIMUM WAGE TO THE COM-
- 14 MONWEALTH OF THE NORTHERN MARIANA
- 15 ISLANDS.
- The provisions of section 6 of the Fair Labor Stand-
- 17 ards Act of 1938 (29 U.S.C. 206) shall apply to the Com-
- 18 monwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands.
