3 **SECTION 1. REDESIGNATION.**

4 The Federal building located at 701 South Santa Fe
5 Avenue in Compton, California, and known as the Comp-
6 ton Main Post Office, shall be known and designated as
7 the “Mervyn Malcolm Dymally Post Office Building”.

1 **SEC. 2. REFERENCES.**

2 Any reference in a law, map, regulation, document,
3 paper, or other record of the United States to the Federal
4 building referred to in section 1 shall be deemed to be
5 a reference to the Mervyn Malcolm Dymally Post Office
6 Building.
