## AN ACT

To authorize the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to the provisions of the Reclamation Wastewater and Groundwater Study and Facilities Act to participate in the design, planning, and construction of the Denver Water Reuse project.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. DENVER WATER REUSE PROJECT.**

2 (a) AUTHORIZATION.—The Secretary of the Interior,  
3 in cooperation with the appropriate State and local au-  
4 thorities, may participate in the design, planning, and con-  
5 struction of the Denver Water Reuse Project (“Project”)  
6 to reclaim and reuse water in the service area of the Den-  
7 ver Water Department of the city and county of Denver,  
8 Colorado.

9 (b) COST SHARE.—The Federal share of the cost of  
10 the Project shall not exceed 25 percent of the total cost.

11 (c) LIMITATION.—Funds provided by the Secretary  
12 shall not be used for the operation and maintenance of  
13 the Project.

14 (d) FUNDING.—Funds appropriated pursuant to sec-  
15 tion 1615 of the Reclamation Wastewater and Ground-  
16 water Study and Facilities Act may be used for the  
17 Project.

18 **SEC. 2. RECLAMATION WASTEWATER AND GROUNDWATER**  
19 **STUDY AND FACILITIES ACT.**

20 Design, planning, and construction of the Project au-  
21 thorized by the Act shall be in accordance with, and sub-  
22 ject to the limitations contained in, the Reclamation  
23 Wastewater and Groundwater Study and Facilities Act

1 (106 Stat. 4663–4669, 43 U.S.C. 390h *et seq.*), as amend-  
2 ed.
