- 8 (b) Conforming Amendment.—Paragraph (1) of
- 9 section 45C(b) of such Code is amended by striking sub-
- 10 paragraph (D).

- 1 (c) Effective Date.—The amendments made by
- 2 this section shall apply to amounts paid or incurred after

3 June 30, 1999.
