- 3 shall be construed to prohibit a United States citizen from

- 5 as of November 19, 1999, under subchapter II of chapter
- 6 5 and chapter 7 of title 5, United States Code (commonly
- 7 referred to as the Administrative Procedures Act), or any
- 8 other provision of law, with respect to the blocking of as-
- 9 sets by the United States under the Foreign Kingpin Des-
