**A BILL**

To clarify the standing of United States citizens to challenge the blocking of assets by the United States under the Foreign Narcotics Kingpin Designation Act.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. CLARIFICATION OF STANDING OF UNITED**  
4                       **STATES CITIZENS TO CHALLENGE BLOCKING**  
5                       **OF ASSETS.**

6       Notwithstanding any provision of the Foreign Nar-  
7       cotics Kingpin Designation Act (title VIII of the Intel-

1   ligence Authorization Act for Fiscal Year 2000), no provi-  
2   sion of the Foreign Narcotics Kingpin Designation Act  
3   shall be construed to prohibit a United States citizen from  
4   raising any challenge available to the United States citizen  
5   as of November 19, 1999, under subchapter II of chapter  
6   5 and chapter 7 of title 5, United States Code (commonly  
7   referred to as the Administrative Procedures Act), or any  
8   other provision of law, with respect to the blocking of as-  
9   sets by the United States under the Foreign Kingpin Des-  
10   ignation Act.
