3       **SECTION 1. PERMANENT MORATORIUM ON IMPOSITION OF**  
4       **TAXES ON THE INTERNET.**

5       Section 1101(a) of the Omnibus Consolidated and  
6       Emergency Supplemental Appropriations Act, 1999 is  
7       amended by striking “during the period beginning on Oc-

1 tober 1, 1998, and ending 3 years after the date of the  
2 enactment of this Act” and inserting “after September 30,  
3 1998”.
