To amend title XVIII of the Social Security Act to extend the option to use rebased target amounts to all sole community hospitals.

6 SEC. 2. EXTENSION OF OPTION TO USE REBASED TARGET

7 AMOUNTS TO ALL SOLE COMMUNITY HOS-8 PITALS.

9 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 1886(b)(3)(I)(i) of the
10 Social Security Act (42 U.S.C. 1395ww(b)(3)(I)(i)) (as

4	113) is amended—

5 (1) in the matter preceding subclause (I)—
6 (A) by striking "for its cost reporting pe7 riod beginning during 1999 is paid on the basis
8 of the target amount applicable to the hospital
9 under subparagraph (C) and that"; and

(B) by striking "such target amount" and
inserting "the target amount otherwise applicable to the hospital under subparagraph (C) (referred to in this clause as the 'subparagraph
(C) target amount')"; and

(2) in subclause (I), by striking "target amount
otherwise applicable" and all that follows through
"target amount")" and inserting "subparagraph (C)
target amount".

(b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by
this section shall apply as if included in the enactment
of the Medicare, Medicaid, and SCHIP Balanced Budget
Refinement Act of 1999, as enacted into law by section
1000(a)(6) of Public Law 106–113.

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
