5	(a) Nicaraguan Adjustment and Central
6	AMERICAN RELIEF ACT.—Notwithstanding the expiration
7	of the application filing deadline in section 202(a)(1) of
8	the Nicaraguan Adjustment and Central American Relief
9	Act (as contained in Public Law 105–100; 8 U.S.C. 1255
10	note), a Cuban or Nicaraguan national who is otherwise
11	eligible for adjustment of status under that section may
12	apply for that status through the date that is one year
13	after the date of promulgation by the Attorney General
14	of final regulations for the implementation of that section.
15	(b) Haitian Refugee Immigration Fairness
16	ACT.—Notwithstanding the expiration of the application
17	filing deadline in section 902(a) of the Haitian Refugee
18	Immigration Fairness Act of 1998 (as added by section
19	101(h) of division A of Public Law 105–277), a Haitian
20	national who is otherwise eligible for adjustment of status
21	under that section may apply for that status through the
22	date that is one year after the date of promulgation by
23	the Attorney General of final regulations for the imple-
24	mentation of that section.
