To suspend temporarily the duty on HIV/AIDS drugs.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. 5-[(3,5-DICHLOROPHENYL)THIO]-4-(1-**
4 **METHYLETHYL)-1-(4-PYRIDINYLMETHYL)-1H-**
5 **IMIDAZOLE-2-METHANOL CARBAMATE.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of
7 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is
8 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following
9 new headings:

1 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
 2 subsection (a) applies with respect to goods entered, or
 3 withdrawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after
