A BILL

To suspend temporarily the duty on certain fluoride compounds.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. FLUORIDE COMPOUNDS.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of
5 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is
6 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following
7 new headings:

“	9902.28.11	Ammonium bifluoride (CAS No. 1341-49-7) (provided for in subheading 2826.11.10)	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/2004	”.
	9902.28.12	Potassium fluoride tantalum grade (CAS No. 7789-23-3) (provided for in subheading 2826.19.00)	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/2004	

1 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
2 subsection (a) shall apply with respect to goods entered,
3 or withdrawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after
4 the date that is 15 days after the date of enactment of
5 this Act.
