- 5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subheading 9902.71.08 of the
- 6 Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is
- 7 amended by striking "12/31/2000" and inserting "12/31/2000"
- 8 2005".

- 1 (b) Effective Date.—The amendment made by
- 2 subsection (a) applies with respect to goods entered, or
- 3 withdrawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after

4 the 15th day after the date of enactment of this Act.
