A BILL

To suspend through December 31, 2004, the duty on certain other single yarn of viscose rayon.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SUSPENSION OF DUTY.**

4 Subchapter II of chapter 99 of the Harmonized Tar-
5 iff Schedule of the United States is amended by inserting
6 in numerical sequence the following new heading:

“	9902.xx.xx	Other yarn, single: Of viscose rayon, untwisted or with a twist not exceeding 120 turns/m-Monofilament; multifilament, untwisted or with twist of less than 5 turns per meter (provided for in subheading 5403.31.00.20)	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/2004	”.
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1 **SEC. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE.**

2 The amendment made by section 1 shall apply to
3 goods entered, or withdrawn from warehouse for consump-
4 tion, on or after the date that is 15 days after the date
5 of the enactment of this Act.

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
