- 7 (a) Length of Term.—The term of office as Under
- 8 Secretary for Nuclear Security of the Department of En-

- 3 (b) Exclusive Reasons for Removal.—The ex-
- 4 clusive reasons for removal from office as Under Secretary
- 5 for Nuclear Security of the person described in subsection
- 6 (a) shall be inefficiency, neglect of duty, or malfeasance
- 7 in office.
- 8 (c) Position Described.—The position of Under
- 9 Secretary for Nuclear Security of the Department of En-
- 10 ergy referred to in this section is the position established
- 11 by subsection (c) of section 202 of the Department of En-
- 12 ergy Organization Act (42 U.S.C. 7132), as added by sec-
- 13 tion 3202 of the National Nuclear Security Administration
- 14 Act (title XXXII of Public Law 106-65; 113 Stat. 954)).
