A BILL

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “National Missile De-
5 fense Act of 1999”.

1 **SEC. 2. NATIONAL MISSILE DEFENSE POLICY.**

2 It is the policy of the United States to deploy as soon
3 as is technologically possible an effective National Missile
4 Defense system capable of defending the territory of the
5 United States against limited ballistic missile attack
6 (whether accidental, unauthorized, or deliberate).
