To amend the Tariff Act of 1930 to clarify that forced or indentured labor includes forced or indentured child labor.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. FORCED OR INDENTURED CHILD LABOR.**

4 Section 307 of the Tariff Act of 1930 (19 U.S.C.
5 1307) is amended by adding at the end the following new
6 sentence: “For purposes of this section, the term ‘forced
7 labor or/and indentured labor’ includes forced or inden-
8 tured child labor.”.
