## A BILL

To provide for a Dekalb-Peachtree Airport buyout initiative.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. DEKALB-PEACHTREE AIRPORT BUYOUT PRIOR-
- 4 ITY AIRPORT DESIGNATION AND AUTHORIZA-
- 5 TION OF FUNDS.
- 6 (a) In General.—The Administrator of the Federal
- 7 Aviation Administration shall grant a priority airport des-
- 8 ignation for the Dekalb-Peachtree Airport in Georgia, for
- 9 the purposes of a buyout initiative for that airport.
- 10 (b) Funding.—The Administrator of the Federal
- 11 Aviation Administration shall make available \$35,000,000

1	for a Dekalb-Peachtree Airport buyout initiative, of
2	which—
3	(1) \$14,600,000 shall be used for the purchase
4	of 110 residential properties; and
5	(2) \$17,900,000 shall be used for the purchase
6	of 23 commercial properties and the relocation of all
7	occupants of the properties referred to in paragraph
8	(1) and this paragraph.
