- 6 Emergency Supplemental Appropriations Act, 1999 is
- 7 amended by striking "during the period beginning on Oc-
- 8 tober 1, 1998, and ending 3 years after the date of the

- 1 enactment of this Act' and inserting "after September 30,
- 2 1998".
