A BILL

To amend title 38, United States Code, to extend eligibility for hospital care and medical services under chapter 17 of that title to veterans who have been awarded the Purple Heart, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. ELIGIBILITY FOR HOSPITAL CARE AND MEDI-**
4 **CAL SERVICES BASED ON AWARD OF PURPLE**
5 **HEART.**

6 (a) ELIGIBILITY.—Section 1710(a)(2) of title 38,
7 United States Code, is amended—

1 (1) by striking “or” at the end of subparagraph
2 (F);

3 (2) by redesignating subparagraph (G) as sub-
4 paragraph (H); and

5 (3) by inserting after subparagraph (F) the fol-
6 lowing new subparagraph (G):

7 “(G) who has been awarded the Purple Heart;
8 or”.

9 (b) ENROLLMENT PRIORITY.—Section 1705(a)(3) of
10 such title is amended—

11 (1) by striking “and veterans” and inserting
12 “veterans”; and

13 (2) by inserting “, and veterans whose eligibility
14 for care and services under this chapter is based
15 solely on the award of the Purple Heart” before the
16 period at the end.

17 (c) CONFORMING AMENDMENTS.—(1) Section
18 1722(a) of such title is amended by striking “section
19 1710(a)(2)(G)” and inserting “section 1710(a)(2)(H)”.

20 (2) Section 5317(c)(3) of such title is amended by
21 striking “subsections (a)(2)(G),” and inserting “sub-
22 sections (a)(2)(H),”.

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
