- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Emergency Spending
- 5 Control Act of 1999".
- 6 SEC. 2. PRESIDENT'S BUDGET.
- 7 Section 1105(b) of title 31, United States Code, is
- 8 amended by adding at the end the following:
- 9 "(33) a separate appropriation account for ap-
- propriations for emergency spending for emergency
- requirements (as defined in section 250(c) of the

- 1 Balanced Budget and Emergency Deficit Control
- 2 Act of 1985) that equals the annual average of
- 3 emergency spending for emergency requirements in
- 4 the 5 fiscal years preceding the budget year.".

5 SEC. 3. LIMITATION OF EMERGENCY SPENDING TO NATU-

- 6 RAL DISASTERS.
- 7 Section 250(c) of the Balanced Budget and Emer-
- 8 gency Deficit Control Act of 1985 (2 U.S.C. 900(c)) is
- 9 amended by adding at the end the following:
- 10 "(20) The term 'emergency requirement' means
- appropriations or spending for a natural disaster de-
- clared by the President.".
- 13 SEC. 4. EFFECTIVE DATE.
- 14 This Act and the amendments made by this Act shall
- 15 apply to fiscal years beginning with fiscal year 2001.
