Mr. CLELAND introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Finance

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## A BILL

To provide States with the authority to permit certain employers of domestic workers to make annual wage reports.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. AUTHORIZATION FOR STATE TO PERMIT AN-**  
4       **NUAL WAGE REPORTS.**

5       (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 1137(a)(3) of the Social  
6       Security Act (42 U.S.C. 1320b–7(a)(3)) is amended by  
7       inserting before the semicolon the following: “, and except  
8       that in the case of wage reports with respect to domestic  
9       service employment, a State may permit employers (as so  
10      defined) that make returns with respect to such service

1 on a calendar year basis pursuant to section 3510 of the  
2 Internal Revenue Code of 1986 to make such reports on  
3 an annual basis”.

4 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by  
5 subsection (a) shall apply to wage reports required to be  
6 submitted on and after the date of enactment of this Act.

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
