- 3 SECTION 1. COMMERCIAL OPERATION OF SUPERSONIC
- 4 TRANSPORT CATEGORY AIRCRAFT.
- 5 The Secretary of Transportation shall prohibit the
- 6 commercial operation of civil supersonic transport cat-
- 7 egory aircraft to or from an airport in the United States—
- 8 (1) if the Secretary determines that the Euro-
- 9 pean Union has adopted Common Position (EC) No.
- 10 66/98 as a final regulation, unless

- 1 (2) the Secretary also determines that such air-
- 2 craft comply with Stage 3 noise levels.
