- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Civil Rights of Infants
- 5 Act".

SEC. 2. DEPRIVING PERSONS OF THE EQUAL PROTECTION 2 OF LAWS BEFORE BIRTH. 3 Section 1979 of the Revised Statutes (42 U.S.C. 4 1983) is amended— (1) by inserting "(a)" before "Every person"; 5 6 and 7 (2) by adding at the end the following: "(b) For purposes of subsection (a), it shall be a dep-8 rivation of a 'right' secured by the laws of the United States for an individual to perform an abortion with the 10 11 knowledge that the pregnant woman is seeking the abortion solely because of the gender of the fetus. No pregnant woman who seeks to obtain an abortion solely because of the gender of the fetus shall be liable for such abortion 15 in any manner under this section.".
