A BILL

For the relief of Ricke Kaname Fujino.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. PAYMENT REQUIRED.
- 4 Notwithstanding any other provision of law or any
- 5 previous order or dismissal of any suit, the Secretary of
- 6 the Treasury is authorized and directed to pay, out of any
- 7 money in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated, to
- 8 Ricke Kaname Fujino of Honolulu, Hawaii in full satisfac-
- 9 tion of all of his claims against the United States for the
- 10 taking of property of Ricke Kaname Fujino pursuant to
- 11 Vesting Order No. 2724 issued under the authority of the

- 1 Trading with the Enemy Act on December 3, 1943, a sum
- 2 equal to the lesser of—
- 3 (1) the fair market value of the property on the
- 4 date of enactment of this Act, or
- 5 (2) \$8,000,000.

6 SEC. 2. LIMITATION.

- 7 Notwithstanding any contract to the contrary, it shall
- 8 be unlawful to pay or deliver to any agent or attorney,
- 9 and for any agent or attorney to receive, on account of
- 10 services rendered in connection with the claims paid pur-
- 11 suant to section 1, any amount exceeding 10 percent of
- 12 the amount so paid. Violation of the provisions of this sec-
- 13 tion is a misdemeanor punishable by a fine not to exceed
- 14 \$1,000.
