A BILL

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Freedom of Speech
- 5 Act".

SEC. 2. PROHIBITION.

2	(a) IN GENERAL.—No agency, officer, or employee
3	of the executive branch of the Federal Government shall
4	issue, implement, or enforce any policy establishing an ad-
5	ditional class of individuals that is protected against dis-
6	crimination in Federal employment, other than a class of
7	individuals specifically identified in a provision of Federal
8	statutory law that prohibits employment discrimination
9	against the class, including—
10	(1) title VII of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 (42
11	U.S.C. 2000e et seq.);
12	(2) the Age Discrimination in Employment Act
13	of 1967 (29 U.S.C. 621 et seq.); and
14	(3) title V of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973 (29
15	U.S.C. 791 et seq.) or title I of the Americans with
16	Disabilities Act of 1990 (42 U.S.C. 12111 et seq.)
17	(b) Prohibition on Use of Federal Funds.—No
18	agency, officer, or employee of the executive branch of the
19	Federal Government shall use Federal funds to issue im-

20 plement, or enforce a policy described in subsection (a),

21 including implementing and enforcing Executive Order

22 13087, including any amendment made by such order.
