To redesignate Great Kills Park in the Gateway National Recreation Area as "World War II Veterans Park at Great Kills".

1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, SECTION 1. DESIGNATION OF PORTION OF GATEWAY NA-4 TIONAL RECREATION AREA AS WORLD WAR II 5 VETERANS PARK AT GREAT KILLS. 6 Section 3(b) of Public Law 92–592 (16 U.S.C. 7 460cc–2(b)) is amended— (1) by inserting "(1)" after "(b)"; and 8 9 (2) by adding at the end the following new

"(2) The portion of the Staten Island Unit of 1 2 the recreation area known as Great Kills Park is 3 hereby redesignated as 'World War II Veterans Park 4 at Great Kills'. Any reference to Great Kills Park in 5 any law, regulation, map, document, record, or other 6 paper of the United States shall be considered to be a reference to 'World War II Veterans Park at 7 Great Kills'.". 8
