- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. PROHIBITION ON IMPLEMENTATION.
- 4 (a) In General.—No regulation or amendment
- 5 thereto prescribed by the Secretary of the Treasury or any
- 6 Federal banking agency under subchapter II or III of
- 7 chapter 53 of title 31, United States Code, chapter 2 of

- 1 Public Law 91–508, or any other provision of Federal law,
- 2 that requires a depository institution or any other private
- 3 entity to obtain information concerning any person in con-
- 4 nection with a financial transaction between such person
- 5 and the depository institution or other private entity (com-
- 6 monly referred to as "know your customer" regulations)
- 7 may be implemented or otherwise take effect on or after
- 8 the date of enactment of this Act.
- 9 (b) Definitions.—The terms "Federal banking
- 10 agency" and "depository institution" have the same mean-
- 11 ings as in section 3 of the Federal Deposit Insurance Act.
