Mr. BIDEN introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Energy and Natural Resources

## A BILL

To direct the Secretary of the Interior to make corrections to a map relating to the Coastal Barrier Resources System.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. CORRECTIONS TO MAP.**

4       (a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 30 days after the  
5       date of enactment of this Act, the Secretary of the Interior  
6       shall make such corrections to the map described in sub-  
7       section (b) as are necessary to move on that map the  
8       boundary of the otherwise protected area (as defined in  
9       section 12 of the Coastal Barrier Improvement Act of  
10       1990 (16 U.S.C. 3503 note; Public Law 101–591)) to the

1 Cape Henlopen State Park boundary to the extent  
2 necessary—

3           (1) to exclude from the otherwise protected area  
4       the adjacent property leased, as of the date of enact-  
5       ment of this Act, by the Barcroft Company and  
6       Cape Shores Associates (which are privately held  
7       corporations under the law of the State of Dela-  
8       ware); and

9           (2) to include in the otherwise protected area  
10      the northwestern corner of Cape Henlopen State  
11      Park seaward of the Lewes and Rehoboth Canal.

12      (b) MAP DESCRIBED.—The map described in this  
13      subsection is the map that is included in a set of maps  
14      entitled “Coastal Barrier Resources System”, dated Octo-  
15      ber 24, 1990, as revised October 15, 1992, and that re-  
16      lates to the unit of the Coastal Barrier Resources System  
17      entitled “Cape Henlopen Unit DE-03P”.
