A BILL

For the relief of Janina Altagracia Castillo-Rojas and her husband, Diogenes Patricio Rojas.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. PERMANENT RESIDENCE.
- 4 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, for pur-
- 5 poses of the Immigration and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C.
- 6 1101 et seq.), Janina Altagracia Castillo-Rojas and her
- 7 husband, Diogenes Patricio Rojas, shall be held and con-
- 8 sidered to have been lawfully admitted to the United
- 9 States for permanent residence as of the date of the enact-
- 10 ment of this Act upon payment of the required visa fees.

1 SEC. 2. REDUCTION OF NUMBER OF AVAILABLE VISAS.

- 2 Upon the granting of permanent residence to Janina
- 3 Altagracia Castillo-Rojas and her husband, Diogenes
- 4 Patricio Rojas, as provided in this Act, the Secretary of
- 5 State shall instruct the proper officer to reduce by the ap-
- 6 propriate number during the current fiscal year the total
- 7 number of immigrant visas available to natives of the
- 8 country of the aliens' birth under section 203(a) of the
- 9 Immigration and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C. 1153(a)).
