6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subparagraph (E) of section
7 42(i)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (relating
8 to determination of whether building is federally sub9 sidized) is amended—

(1) in clause (i), by inserting "or the Native
American Housing Assistance and Self-Determination Act of 1996 (25 U.S.C. 4101 et seq.) (as in effect on October 1, 1997)" after "this subparagraph)", and

(2) in the subparagraph heading, by inserting
"OR NATIVE AMERICAN HOUSING ASSISTANCE" after
"HOME ASSISTANCE".

(b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made bysubsection (a) shall apply to periods after the date of theenactment of this Act.

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
