Mrs. FEINSTEIN introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on the Judiciary

## A BILL

To ban the importation of large capacity ammunition feeding devices.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4       This Act may be cited as the “Large Capacity Ammu-  
5       nition Magazine Import Ban Act of 1999”.

6       **SEC. 2. BAN ON IMPORTING LARGE CAPACITY AMMUNI-**  
7       **TION FEEDING DEVICES.**

8       Section 922(w) of title 18, United States Code, is  
9       amended—

1           (1) in paragraph (1), by striking “(1) Except as  
2       provided in paragraph (2)” and inserting “(1)(A)  
3       Except as provided in subparagraph (B)”;

4           (2) in paragraph (2), by striking “(2) Para-  
5       graph (1)” and inserting “(B) Subparagraph (A)”;

6           (3) by inserting before paragraph (3) the fol-  
7       lowing:

8       “(2) It shall be unlawful for any person to import  
9       a large capacity ammunition feeding device.”; and

10          (4) in paragraph (4)—

11               (A) by striking “(1)” each place it appears  
12               and inserting “(1)(A)”;

13               (B) by striking “(2)” and inserting  
14               “(1)(B)”.

15   **SEC. 3. CONFORMING AMENDMENT.**

16       Section 921(a)(31) of title 18, United States Code,  
17   is amended by striking “manufactured after the date of  
18   enactment of the Violent Crime Control and Law Enforce-  
19   ment Act of 1994”.
