AN ACT

To amend the Safe and Drug-Free Schools and Communities Act of 1994 to prevent the abuse of inhalants through programs under that Act, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

1 SECTION 1. DEFINITIONS.

2 Section 4131 of the Safe and Drug-Free Schools and
3 Communities Act of 1994 (20 U.S.C. 7141) is amended
4 by adding at the end the following:

"(7) ABUSE.—The term 'abuse', used with re-5 6 spect to an inhalant, means the intentional breath-7 ing of gas or vapors from the inhalant for the pur-8 pose of achieving an altered state of consciousness. "(8) DRUG.—The term 'drug' includes a sub-9 10 stance that is an inhalant, whether or not possession 11 or consumption of the substance is legal. 12 "(9) INHALANT.—The term 'inhalant' means a

13 product that—

14 "(A) may be a legal, commonly available15 product; and

"(B) has a useful purpose but can be
abused, such as spray paint, glue, gasoline, correction fluid, furniture polish, a felt tip marker,
pressurized whipped cream, an air freshener,
butane, or cooking spray.

21 "(10) USE.—The term 'use', used with respect
22 to an inhalant, means abuse of the inhalant.".

23 SEC. 2. FINDINGS.

Section 4002 of the Safe and Drug-Free Schools and
Communities Act of 1994 (20 U.S.C. 7102) is amended—

1	(1) in paragraph (2) , by inserting ", and the
2	abuse of inhalants," after "other drugs";
3	(2) in paragraph (5), by striking "and the ille-
4	gal use of alcohol and drugs" and inserting ", the
5	illegal use of alcohol and drugs, and the abuse of
6	inhalants'';
7	(3) in paragraph (7), by striking "and tobacco"
8	each place it appears and inserting ", tobacco, and
9	inhalants'';
10	(4) in paragraph (9), by striking "and illegal
11	drug use" and inserting ", illegal drug use, and in-
12	halant abuse"; and
13	(5) by adding at the end the following:
14	"(11)(A) The number of children using
15	inhalants has doubled during the 10-year period pre-
16	ceding 1999. Inhalants are the third most abused
17	class of substances by children age 12 through 14 in
18	the United States, behind alcohol and tobacco. One
19	of 5 students in the United States has tried
20	inhalants by the time the student has reached the
21	8th grade.
22	"(B) Inhalant vapors react with fatty tissues in
23	the brain, literally dissolving the tissues. A single
24	use of inhalants can cause instant and permanent
25	brain, heart, kidney, liver, and other organ damage.

The user of an inhalant can suffer from Sudden
 Sniffing Death Syndrome, which can cause a user to
 die the first, tenth, or hundredth time the user uses
 an inhalant.

5 "(C) Because inhalants are legal, education on
6 the dangers of inhalant abuse is the most effective
7 method of preventing the abuse of inhalants.".

8 SEC. 3. PURPOSE.

9 Section 4003 of the Safe and Drug-Free Schools and
10 Communities Act of 1994 (20 U.S.C. 7103) is amended,
11 in the matter preceding paragraph (1), by inserting "and
12 abuse of inhalants" after "and drugs".

13 SEC. 4. GOVERNOR'S PROGRAMS.

Section 4114(c)(2) of the Safe and Drug-Free
Schools and Communities Act of 1994 (20 U.S.C.
7114(c)(2)) is amended by inserting "(including inhalant
abuse education)" after "drug and violence prevention".
SEC. 5. DRUG AND VIOLENCE PREVENTION PROGRAMS.

Section 4116 of the Safe and Drug-Free Schools and
Communities Act of 1994 (20 U.S.C. 7116) is amended—

- 21 (1) in subsection (a)(1)(A), by inserting ", and
- the abuse of inhalants," after "illegal drugs"; and
- (2) in subsection (b) -
- 24 (A) in paragraph (1) -

1	(i) by inserting "and the abuse of
2	inhalants" after "use of illegal drugs"; and
3	(ii) by inserting "and abuse
4	inhalants" after "use illegal drugs"; and
5	(B) in paragraph (2)—
6	(i) in the matter preceding subpara-
7	graph (A), by inserting "(including age ap-
8	propriate inhalant abuse prevention pro-
9	grams for all students, from the preschool
10	level through grade 12)" after "drug pre-
11	vention"; and
12	(ii) in subparagraph (C), by inserting
13	"and inhalant abuse" after "drug use".
14	SEC. 6. FEDERAL ACTIVITIES.
15	Section 4121(a) of the Safe and Drug-Free Schools
16	and Communities Act of 1994 (20 U.S.C. 7131(a)) is
17	amended, in the first sentence, by striking "illegal use of
18	drugs" and inserting "illegal use of drugs, the abuse of

19 inhalants,".

20 SEC. 7. MATERIALS.

Section 4132(a) of the Safe and Drug-Free Schools
and Communities Act of 1994 (20 U.S.C. 7142(a)) is
amended by striking "illegal use of alcohol and other
drugs" and inserting "illegal use of alcohol and other
drugs and the abuse of inhalants".

1 SEC. 8. QUALITY RATING.

2 Section 4134(b)(1) of the Safe and Drug-Free
3 Schools and Communities Act of 1994 (20 U.S.C.
4 7144(b)(1)) is amended by inserting ", and the abuse of
5 inhalants," after "tobacco".
