- 8 "(x) Grape Juice Concentrates.—Any grape
- 9 juice concentrate of degrees brix 68–70 shall be considered
- 10 as 'of the same kind and quality' for purposes of sub-

- 1 section (b) of this section, regardless of color, variety, or
- 2 any other characteristic.".
- 3 (b) Effective Date.—The amendment made by
- 4 this section shall take effect on the date of enactment of
- 5 this Act, and shall apply to any drawback claim filed on

6 or after such date.
