## A BILL

To designate the Federal building located at 290 Broadway in New York, New York, as the “Ronald H. Brown Federal Building”.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. DESIGNATION OF RONALD H. BROWN FEDERAL**  
4       **BUILDING.**

5       The Federal building located at 290 Broadway in  
6       New York, New York, shall be known and designated as  
7       the “Ronald H. Brown Federal Building”.

1 **SEC. 2. REFERENCES.**

2       Any reference in a law, map, regulation, document,  
3 paper, or other record of the United States to the building  
4 referred to in section 1 shall be deemed to be a reference  
5 to the “Ronald H. Brown Federal Building”.
