A BILL

To amend the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 to maintain exemption of Alaska from dyeing requirements for exempt diesel fuel and kerosene.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 (a) EXCEPTION TO DYEING REQUIREMENTS FOR EX-
4 EMPT DIESEL FUEL AND KEROSENE.—Paragraph (1) of
5 section 4082(c) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (re-
6 lating to exception to dyeing requirements) is amended to
7 read as follows:

8 “(1) removed, entered, or sold in the State of
9 Alaska for ultimate sale or use in such State, and”.

1 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
2 this section applies with respect to fuel removed, entered,
3 or sold on or after the date of the enactment of this Act.
