 4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 924 of title 18, United

- 7 (A) in paragraph (2), by striking "(i),
- 8 (j),"; and
- 9 (B) by adding at the end the following:

- 1 "(7) Whoever knowingly violates subsection (i) or (j) 2 of section 922 shall be fined under this title, imprisoned 3 not more than 15 years, or both.";
- 4 (2) in subsection (i)(1), by striking "10 years"
- 5 and inserting "15 years"; and
- 6 (3) in subsection (l), by striking "10 years" and inserting "15 years".

- 9 Sentencing Commission shall amend the Federal sen-
- 10 tencing guidelines to reflect the amendments made by sub-
- 11 section (a).
