(a) IN GENERAL.—Section 2503(b) of the Internal 4 5 Revenue Code of 1986 (relating to exclusions from gifts) is amended— (1) by striking "\$10,000" each place it appears 7 and inserting "\$25,000", 8 (2) by striking "1998" in paragraph (2) and in-9

serting "2000", and

- 2 inserting "1999".
- 3 (b) Effective Date.—The amendments made by
- 4 this section shall apply to gifts made after December 31,
