 - 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
 - 4 This Act may be cited as the "Safe Seniors Assurance
 - 5 Study Act of 1999".
 - 6 SEC. 2. ANESTHESIA OUTCOME STUDY.
 - 7 (a) Study.—

- 1 (1) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of Health and
 2 Human Services shall conduct a study concerning
 3 the mortality and adverse outcome rates of medicare
 4 patients related to the provision of anesthesia serv5 ices. In conducting such study, the Secretary shall
 6 analyze the impact of physician supervision of pro7 viders of anesthesia services, or lack thereof, on such
 8 mortality and adverse outcome rates.
 - (2) Consultation.—In conducting the study under paragraph (1), the Secretary of Health and Human Services shall consult with appropriate national professional organizations with respect to the methodology of the study, and shall use medicare operating room anesthesia data, adjusted for patient acuity and other relevant scientific variables.
- 16 (b) Report.—Not later than June 30, 2000, the 17 Secretary of Health and Human Services shall prepare 18 and submit to the appropriate committees of Congress a 19 report containing the results of the study conducted under 20 subsection (a).
- 21 (c) Consideration of Report in Rulemaking.— 22 The Secretary of Health and Human Services shall con-23 sider the results of the study conducted under subsection 24 (a) when determining if any modification or amendment 25 to medicare regulations promulgated under title XVIII of

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- 1 the Social Security Act (42 U.S.C. 1395 et seq.), and in

3 vision of anesthesia services is appropriate.

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
