## A BILL

For the relief of Corina Dechalup.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. PERMANENT RESIDENCE.
- 4 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, for pur-
- 5 poses of the Immigration and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C.
- 6 1101 et seq.), Corina Dechalup shall be held and consid-
- 7 ered to have been lawfully admitted to the United States
- 8 for permanent residence as of the date of the enactment
- 9 of this Act upon payment of the required visa fees.
- 10 SEC. 2. REDUCTION OF NUMBER OF AVAILABLE VISAS.
- 11 Upon the granting of permanent residence to Corina
- 12 Dechalup, as provided in this Act, the Secretary of State

- 1 shall instruct the proper officer to reduce by the appro-
- 2 priate number during the current fiscal year the total
- 3 number of immigrant visas available to natives of the
- 4 country of the aliens' birth under section 203(a) of the

5 Immigration and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C. 1153(a)).
