- 5 (a) Deauthorization.—The portion of the project
- 6 for navigation, Searsport Harbor, Searsport, Maine, au-
- 7 thorized by section 101 of the River and Harbor Act of
- 8 1962 (76 Stat. 1173), described in subsection (b) is not
- 9 authorized after the date of enactment of this Act.

- 2 ferred to in subsection (a) is the portion of the 35-foot
- 3 turning basin beginning at a point with coordinates
- 4 N225,008.38, E395,464.26, thence running north 43 de-

- 6 N225,269.52, E395,714.96, thence running south 71 de-
- 7 grees 27 minutes 33.0 seconds east 1,309.201 feet to a
- 8 point N224,853.22, E396,956.21, thence running north
- 9 84 degrees 3 minutes 45.7 seconds west 1,499.997 feet
