A BILL

To deauthorize the project for navigation, Carvers Harbor,
Vinalhaven, Maine.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. DEAUTHORIZATION OF PROJECT FOR NAVIGA-**
4 **TION, CARVERS HARBOR, MAINE.**

5 (a) DEAUTHORIZATION.—The portion of the project
6 for navigation, Carvers Harbor, Vinalhaven, Maine, au-
7 thorized by the Act of June 3, 1896 (commonly known
8 as the “River and Harbor Appropriations Act of 1896”)
9 (29 Stat. 202, chapter 314), described in subsection (b)
10 is not authorized after the date of enactment of this Act.

1 (b) DESCRIPTION.—The portion of the project re-
2 ferred to in subsection (a) is the portion of the 16-foot
3 anchorage beginning at a point with coordinates
4 N137,502.04, E895,156.83, thence running south 6 de-
5 grees 34 minutes 57.6 seconds west 277.660 feet to a
6 point N137,226.21, E895,125.00, thence running north
7 53 degrees, 5 minutes 42.4 seconds west 127.746 feet to
8 a point N137,302.92, E895,022.85, thence running north
9 33 degrees 56 minutes 9.8 seconds east 239.999 feet to
10 the point of origin.

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
