- 5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 707(a) of the Public
- 6 Health Service Act (42 U.S.C. 292f(a)) is amended—
- 7 (1) in paragraph (1), by striking "determined,"
- 8 and all that follows through the period and inserting
- 9 "determined.";

- 1 (2) by striking paragraph (2); and 2 (3) by striking "(a) CONDITIONS" and all that 3 follows through "(1) IN GENERAL.—Upon" and in-
- 4 serting the following:
- 5 "(a) Conditions for Payment to Beneficiary.—6 Upon".
- 7 (b) Definition.—Section 707(e) of the Public
- 8 Health Service Act (42 U.S.C. 292f(e)) is amended by
- 9 striking paragraph (4).
- 10 (c) Effective Date.—The amendments made by
- 11 subsections (a) and (b) shall apply with respect to loans
- 12 submitted to the Secretary of Health and Human Services
- 13 for payment on or after May 1, 1999.
