1 **SECTION 1. DESIGNATION OF LEWIS R. MORGAN FEDERAL**
2 **BUILDING AND UNITED STATES COURT-**
3 **HOUSE.**

4 The Federal building and United States courthouse
5 located at 18 Greenville Street in Newnan, Georgia, shall
6 be known and designated as the “Lewis R. Morgan Fed-
7 eral Building and United States Courthouse”.

8 **SEC. 2. REFERENCES.**

9 Any reference in a law, map, regulation, document,
10 paper, or other record of the United States to the Federal
11 building and United States courthouse referred to in sec-
12 tion 1 shall be deemed to be a reference to the “Lewis
13 R. Morgan Federal Building and United States Court-
14 house”.
